Exit Examination of Writing Proficiency – this should be taken as soon as you complete 60 hours (junior status).

Departmental Certification Form - meet with advisor to fill out this form prior to applying for graduation.

Undergraduate Application for Graduation – this can be found online. Submit your application to the Office of the Registrar. Application deadlines for all students are as follows:

- **May graduation: due November 30**
- **December graduation: due June 30**

Senior Assessment - all graduating seniors must complete the required senior assessment survey during their final semester before graduation.

Requirements for graduation include: 1) a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 overall, 2) a minimum grade point average of 2.0 in the major (based on SMGT core courses), 3) 120 earned credit hours, 4) passage of the Exit Examination of Writing Proficiency, and 5) completion of the Senior Assessment. Students must satisfy the university foreign language requirement. This requirement can be waived if the student took three years of one foreign language or two years of two foreign languages in high school. Minor Options A and B require a 2.0 GPA in the minor and no grade below a C-. The GPA for the minor is based on all courses taken from the department (MGMT or MKTG), not just the 15 hours used to complete the minor. For Minor Option C, it is recommended that students take either BIOL 108-109N or BIOL 115-116N for the GEN ED natural science sequence. Option C does not have advisor approved electives. Students must meet with someone in the program area of their minor to declare their minor and certify its completion. See SMGT Internship Requirements Form for information on internships.
